Membership Update

- 1st year OT: 37 (+4)
- 1st year OTA: 9 (+1)
- o OT: 369 (-7)
- OTA: 85 (-4)
- o Retired: 3 (-)
- Student: 295 (-30)
- 40 people renewed their membership and 33 joined in the preceding month.
- o 23 people let their membership lapse and 3 rejoined.
- At this time last year, we had 774 (2,971 including Prospects) active members compared to 818 (3,120 including Prospects) active members as of 5/31/2025.
- This represents a gain of 44 members or a 5.68% increase in overall membership numbers from last year. This increase of members is concentrated in the gain of OT and OTA members.
- This also represents a growth of 149 individuals in TNOTA's audience or a 5.02% increase in the overall audience.
