


TNOTA Audience Report for the period 10/1/25 -10/31/25:

- 3,030 total contacts
- 141 new contacts
- 39 deleted contacts
 - 26 unsubscribe
 - 13 hard bounce

Insights:

- The TNOTA Member Drive was a success, with a high number of new/renewing members coming in just before the end of the drive on October 27
- The period just before the conference (if we are judging by the join/expiration dates migrated over from the old website) is another period of heavier membership growth, with August being our second biggest month for membership in 2025
- "Choose your own incentive" programming like the membership drive is something TNOTA might consider replicating in the future
- OT and Student membership categories continue to dominate the TNOTA member base, which points to opportunities for the specific recruitment of OTA members, especially in their first year of professional practice





Legislative updates

- Government shutdown ended without a vote to extend tax cuts for ACA plans
- There is a potential vote in December
- Current tax cuts for ACA marketplace plans will expire at the end of 2025
 - This could result in high premiums and loss of healthcare coverage
- OT Provider Telehealth provision for Medicare patients was expanded through January 2026

Advocacy Committee

- Annual Advocacy Update CE took place in October
 - This was free for all, and is posted on the website here: https://www.tnota.org/public/advocacy/
- Seven new members on the committee, which should expand our capacity as a committee
- o Currently planning for Hill Day 2026, with a potential date change
- Next committee meeting is Monday, November 17
- The TN Brain Injury Association reached out to see how TNOTA might become a strategic partner

Continuing Education Committee

- All courses that have been submitted up to this point have been reviewed
- We've probably surpassed the total number of courses reviewed in 2024, but need to do a quick audit to confirm this
- Currently we're in a slight lull as the end of the year comes up
- In general this year has been steadier than years past

Mental Health Committee

 - One every other month starting on February 7
 - Increased class size to 60 people
